In all circumstances, with the exception of LM180, an applicant is expected to hold at the time of enrolment the established Leaving Certificate with a minimum of six subjects which must include:

- Two H5 (Higher Level) grades and
- Four O6 (Ordinary Level) grades or four H7 (Higher Level) grades.

In the case of LM180, an applicant is

expected to hold at the time of enrolment the established Leaving Certificate with at least five O6 (Ordinary Level) grades or five H7 (Higher Level) grades. Candidates may continue to fulfil minimum and specific subject requirements from more than one sitting of the Leaving Certificate but only the best six subjects from one sitting will be included for scoring purposes.. Applicants

who have a hearing impairment or a specific learning difficulty may apply for exemption from the second language requirement. Such an exemption is only applicable to those courses where the second language requirement is an O6 (Ordinary Level) grade or a H7 (Higher Level) grade. Please contact the Admissions Office for further information on applying for a second language exemption.

## COMPETITIVE ENTRY

Due to the number and calibre of applicants, qualified candidates to all undergraduate degree programmes who satisfy the minimum and specific entry requirements outlined above, are placed in order of merit based on a points system. The system operates as follows:

- Points are awarded for all Leaving Certificate Higher and Ordinary Level Subjects based on the grades achieved in each subject with the exception of the following subjects
  - Foundation Mathematics
  - Foundation Irish
- Points are awarded for the best six subjects.
- Where applicable the LCVP can be considered for points purposes provided

the minimum entry requirements and specific subject requirements are satisfied.

- The six subjects must be taken at any one sitting of the Leaving Certificate.
- An additional score of 25 points is awarded for grades H1 to H6 in the Higher Leaving Mathematics. The additional scores are only where it is included as one of the applicant's best 6 subjects.

Bonus points are **only** awarded for Higher Level Mathematics at Grade H6 and above and where it is included as one of the applicants best six subjects.

## SUBJECT COMBINATIONS FOR POINTS SCORES

- Physics and Physics and Chemistry count as one subject;
- Chemistry and Physics and Chemistry count as one subject;

- Physics, Chemistry and Physics and Chemistry count as two subjects.
- Any two or three subject combination of: History, Economics, Agricultural

Economics, counts as two subjects except when agricultural economics and economics are combined in which case they count as one subject.

## SPECIAL MATHEMATICS ENTRANCE EXAMINATION

The University holds a special Higher Mathematics Entrance Examination in August each year for students who do not satisfy the maths requirement and who are seeking admission to undergraduate

courses in the Faculty of Science & Engineering. Candidates who achieve sufficient CAO points and satisfy all other entry requirements and who pass this special examination are deemed to have
