#### **STUDENT VETTING/POLICE CLEARANCE CERTIFICATE**

\*\*Any student who has been resident outside of Ireland for more than 6 months since over the age of 16 years are required to produce and submit a Police Clearance Cert for that time period. For those who do not have all their required documentation at Orientation, it may be required to attend the Student vetting session scheduled in GEMS1-007 /GEMS1-008 / GEMS1-009. You will be directed as necessary when you attend the Student vetting session for all EU students.

**Please note:** Submission of all relevant Student vetting and Police Clearance Certificates are compulsory. Failure to submit these documents in a timely manner will prevent you from participating in clinical placements.
