

Rinne Helena Ní Ghearáin PhD i Sochtheangeolaíocht na Gaeilge in Ollscoil Luimnigh. Tá suim aici sa bheartas teanga agus i gcúrsaí teangacha mionlaigh. She teaches and designs course material and resources for Aonad na Gaeilge, UL. In recent years she has taught courses in Language Awareness, Translation and Poetry. Other responsibilities include the provision of targeted support for students in the area of academic writing in Irish.
